AS THE PRESIDENT BEGINS A TROOP DRAWDOWN, LOCAL TROOPS ARE STILL BEING DEPLOYED AND NEED OUR SUPPORT

*Operation SOS (Support Our Soldiers) Is In It's 4th Year of Seeing That
The Needs of Local Soldiers Deployed Overseas Are Met.*

On Saturday August 13, 2011 The Guardian Knights Motorcycle Club, Inc. will host the 4th annual Operation SOS Ride to raise funds for Operation Support Our Soldiers. The ride, which is the biggest annual fund raiser for the project, will originate at Susquehanna Valley Harley-Davidson, travel approx. 85 miles through Harrisburg, the mountains and valleys of Central PA and culminate with a pass through the Fort Indiantown Gap Military Reservation, ending at Memorial Lake State Park at the "Gap" with a light picnic lunch. The cost is \$20 per bike/rider and \$10 per passenger. All proceeds go directly to Operation SOS. Classic cars and trucks are also welcome. Registration begins at 8 am and the ride leaves promptly at 10 am.

Operation SOS provides packages from home to local soldiers deployed overseas. Their web site (www.operationsos.org) provides a point of contact for the soldiers or their families to request specific items that they may need or want. The Guardian Knights then purchase those items and ship them. To date nearly 1000 packages have been provided to individual local troops in Iraq and Afghanistan.

The Guardian Knights MC, Inc. is an LE (law enforcement) club based in the central PA area. They are dedicated to the support of the law enforcement community, military, and our first responders. Having been recognized as a 501(c)3 charitable organization by the IRS, the group regularly supports causes benefiting fallen officers and first responders as well as our military men and women.
